Summary of the presentation of a possible data platform solution using IBM

Introduction

The following is the external summary of the presentation of a possible data platform solution using IBM.

The dialog with the market was conducted in order to make the IT and Development Agency of the Danish Ministry of Taxation, Udviklings- og Forenklingsstyrelsen (UFST), obtain further knowledge of available solutions on the market. The focus of the dialog was for UFST to get inspiration for the work on the later acquisition of a data platform and tools. The market operators were expected to present how their standard products can support the target architecture.

The intention of the dialog with the market has not been to either preselect market operators or to preclude market operators from future tenders, and it will thus not qualify any market operators for or exclude any market operators from future tenders. The focus of the dialog has been to discuss products on the market and the functionality of these products.

Welcome and presentation of the market operator's participants	The market operator welcomed UFST, presented its participants, and ran through the agenda of its presentation.
Session 1. Meeting the identified business needs in the conceptual model	<p>The market operator explained its typical cloud set-up and how its customers can deploy its platform in the cloud or on premises. The market operator pointed out that UFST's conceptual model is a standard and that it matches the market operator's reference architecture very well.</p> <p>Furthermore, the market operator explained how its platform can integrate with other platforms and tools, for instance open source tools, meaning that its solution will support the capabilities stated in the conceptual model.</p> <p>Subsequently, the market operator explained how it will approach the project, including the project management set-up.</p>
Session 2. The ability of the market operator's solution to meet the architectural principles	The market operator went through its principles for building a data platform.
Session 3. The market operator's previous experience with implementing a similar kind of platform	The market operator presented a relevant case for a large public client who has been on a similar journey along with other relevant references.
